Francis McGovern is a professor of law at Duke University and has been a special master, IDC or court appointed expert in approximately 40 settlement distributions involving securities, consumer fraud, personal injury and war reparations. He has also written law review articles about claims resolution facilities. His involvement has been to design or oversee distribution processes, not to implement them, and his academic interest is to develop methodologies for improving the effectiveness and efficiency of claims administration. He received his undergraduate degree from Yale University and his law degree from the University of Virginia. He practiced law at Vinson & Elkins before becoming a Professor of Law.
